# **INSTRUCTIONS TO CANDIDATES**

The candidates are hereby informed that the left-over / vacancies / cancelled LLM seats in Private Unaided LAW colleges will be filled through Institutional spot admissions held at the respective colleges. The candidates desirous to seek admission are informed to contact the **principal of the respective institutions** (refer to the spot admissions schedule).

- ➤ The details of colleges and available vacancies College-wise will be displayed on the college's link and as well as on the notice boards of respective colleges.
- Candidates without original certificates are **not permitted** for spot admissions.
- ➤ Candidate shall be present at the allotted college with all original certificates for spot admissions, the Submitted original certificates shall be returned back to the candidate only after final ratification. The candidate has to submit 2 sets of photo copies of certificates and original transfer certificate (T.C) at the college.
- > Fee reimbursement is **not applicable** to the candidates admitted under Institutional Spot Admissions.

## A. Procedure for Spot Admissions:

- 1. Candidates interested in participating in spot admissions must respond to the notification published in the newspaper by the respective colleges.
- 2. Candidates are required to complete their registration online by using the registration link provided by the respective colleges.
- 3. Only candidates who are registered and eligible under the Convener Quota can participate in spot registration through the college's link.
- 4. Candidates who have not registered for Convener Quota certificate verification may also apply for spot admission by registering and uploading their certificates on or before **16.11.2025**. Only those found eligible after verification will be allowed for spot registration.
- 5. After spot registration candidate receive the acknowledgment copy and the name will be added to the list for spot admissions counseling.
- 6. Spot admissions will be made based on **merit (rank)** obtained in TG PGLCET-2025 following spot admission Guidelines.
- 7. After the successful allotment, the list of candidates who secured a seat through spot admissions will be displayed on the notice board of the respective colleges. Additionally, the allotment details will be sent via SMS to the registered mobile number.
- 8. Candidates who secure admission through spot admissions counseling must report to the college on or before the specified due date and pay the tuition fee. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of the admission, and the seat will be offered to the next candidate on the waiting list.
- 9. Candidates who have already secured a seat in regular or spot counseling and wish to transfer to another college through spot admissions counseling will only be allotted a new seat after canceling their previous admission.

#### D. ELIGIBILITY FOR TG PGLCET- 2025 ADMISSIONS

- The candidate should be of Indian Nationality.
- 2. The candidate should belong to Telangana.
- 3. The candidates should satisfy the local / unreserved status requirements as specified in G.O.Ms.No. 15 Higher Education (TE) Department dated 27-02-2025. Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in each course in the Educational Institutions in the State for the local candidates of O.U. Area as specified in the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulations and Admissions) Order, 1974 as subsequently amended and

#### the remaining 15% of the seats shall be unreserved Seats as follows:

- (i) All the candidates eligible to be declared as local candidates of O.U. Area.
- (ii) Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of study outside the State or either of whose parents have resided in the State for a total period of ten years excluding periods of employment outside the State;
- (iii) Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporation, Local Bodies, Universities and other similar quasi Public Institution within the State; and
- (iv) Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and educational Institutions recognized by the Government or a University or other competent authority and similar other quasi-Government institutions within the State.
- 4. LL.M: Candidates should have passed LL.B/BL from a recognized University.

#### NOTE:

- I. The dropout vacancies (Reported but discontinued) shall be allotted only to that respective category.
- II. Likewise, the not reported and cancelled seats shall be allotted to that respective category.
- III. If a particular category candidate is not available, that seat shall be converted to other categories, finally after exhausting all category candidates, the vacancies shall be converted to open category.
- IV. Candidates from outside Telangana, who completed studies outside the state and have parents residing in other states, are ineligible for admission in Telangana. Even if admission is granted mistakenly, violating these guidelines, it will not be ratified, emphasizing that only candidates with a strong connection to Telangana (domicile, studies, or parents' residence) are eligible.
- V. Seats will be allotted to local candidates only after exhausting local candidates any remaining seats if available will be given to unreserved candidates.
- VI. Furthermore, candidates admitted through institutional spot admissions should be aware that their admission is subject to ratification by the Convenor, TG PGLCET-2025 Admissions. If a candidate's admission is not ratified due to certain technical reasons, he or she will have to forfeit the admission.

# **E. Processing Fee Details**

The candidates have to pay the following non-refundable Processing Fee for each college they apply to Rs. 800.00 (Rupees: Eight Hundred only) and Rs. 500.00 (Rupees: Five Hundred only) in case of (SC/ST Candidates) towards Registration cum Verification process the fee must be paid through colleges online spot registration link.
